Raymond and wife to Henry Taylor dated Nov. 30 1892 and recorded in T.L. Deed Record 7 page 573 records of Madison County, Iowa, was located upon what is now known as Taylors Addition to the Town of Earlham, Iowa and that this slaughter house has been long removed, and there has been no slaughter house on any part of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ fr. 7-77-28 for more than 15 years.
