State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, Lucy A. Bullock, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously for the period of 54 years last past. that I was well and personally acquainted with Ransom M. Porter, to whom A.V. Page and wife Susan S. Page on or about February 13th, 1866, conveyed that part of the North West Quarter (1/4) of the North West Quarter (1/4) of Section ten (10) in Township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty eight (28) west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, lying west of Clanton Creek, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record "T" of said County at page 4 thereof, and who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about September 9th 1893, and that said Ransom M. Porter was the same and identical man as the Ransom Porter to whom Alexander Johnson and wife on or about November 9th, 1863, conveyed the north fifteen acres of the south west quarter (1/4) of the north west quarter (1/4) of said section, township, and range, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record "I" of said County at page 205 thereof, and that he was also the same and identical man as the Ransom Porter to whom J.S. McCaughan and A.R. Dabney on or about May 22nd, 1874, conveyed the north east quarter (1/4) of the north east quarter (1/4) of Section nine (9) in the township, and range aforesaid, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record nine of said county at page 398 thereof, his name appearing as Ransom Porter only by error and mistake, and carelessness in writing; in other words Ransom M. Porter, Ransom Porter, and Ransom Porter was one and the same man, and that he was the same man as the Ransom M. Porter to whom Charles Boling, and his wife Mollie Boling, and Arthusia Boling, who was a widow, on or about May 19th, 1877 conveyed that part of the said north west quarter (1/4) of the north west quarter (1/4) of Section ten (10) in the Township and range aforesaid lying east of Clanton Creek, the conveyance being recorded in deed record 18 of said County at page 172 thereof; that Charles Boling was the husband of said Mollie Boling, and that Arthusia Boling was the widow of Bluford Boling deceased, named in the registry of his heirs as Arthusia Boling. That Lucy Ann Boling named in the registry of heirs of said Bluford Boling is the same person as Lucy Ann Bullock grantor in a conveyance of a part of said real estate to said Charles Boling dated September 4th, 1875, and recorded in deed record 12 of said County at page 320 thereof; that Julia Ann Boling named in said registry of heirs is the same as Julia Ann Callison, also one of the grantors in said deed; that the Elizabeth Wilson named in said registry of heirs is the same person as the Elisabeth Wilson, who with her husband Wm. S. Wilson conveyed a part of said real estate to Wesley Wilson on or about November 1st, 1875, the deed being record in deed record 11 of said County at page 468 thereof. That all of the above facts are stated of my own personal knowledge.
