State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, Lucy A. Bullock, of said County, and state, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than fifty years last past; that I am a daughter of Bluford Boling who entered from the United States Government the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the north east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), all in section eleven (11) in township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of 5th P.M. Iowa; that his name was Bluford Boling, and that he was the same and identical man as the Blueford Boling whose name appears on the records as entering said land; that he was also the same and identical man as the Blufred Boling to whom said land was patented, and was the same and identical man as B. Boling who on or about December 31, 1858, conveyed a part of said land to my brother, Charles Boling, That, in other words, Blueford Boling, Blufred Boling, Bluford Boling, and B. Boling, as the name appears in connection with the title to said land was one and the same man, my father, That I was personally acquainted with Mary A. Long, Margaret Long, and Annie E. Long, the mortgagees in a certain mortgage executed by J.A. Couch and G.W. Couch, covering a part of said land and other land, dated March 10, 1900; that Margaret Long was a widow, and that Mary A. Long and Annie E. Long were her daughters; that Mary A. Long, or Mary Ann Long died intestate leaving her mother, Margaret Long as her sole and only heir at law, and that afterwards said Margaret Long died intestate, both of them dying as I am informed and believe in Polk County, Iowa. That I have no personal interest in this matter, but know the above stated facts.
