I, T.C. Gilpin, of said County and State on oath say that I was acquainted with Ann Smith who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about March 10th, 1880; that I was attorney for plaintiff in the foreclosure suit commenced by A.I. Seeber in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, about October 19th, 1880, and found on Docket seven (7) at page 177 thereof, and that the petition in said cause is in my hand writing; that Isaac H. Smith defendant in said cause was the same man as the I.H. Smith, named in the registry of heirs of said Ann Smith, and was her husband as I believe; that Susan Newcomb defendant in said cause was the same and identical person as Susie Newcomb named in said registry of heirs and that James M. Newcomb was her husband; that George M.
