Kail, first being duly sworn depose and say that I was well acquainted with Josiah Burr Plumb who entered from the U.S. Government the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  13-77-29 February 6<sup>th</sup> 1856 the same being patented to him October 30 1857, as shown by the Book of Original Entries on file in Madison County, Iowa, and I know him to be the same and identical person as J.B. Plumb who with his wife were the grantors in a quit claim deed dated February 26 1851 and recorded in Deed Record "M" page 124 conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  13-77-29 and other land wherein the said Josiah Burr Plumb or J.B. Plumb acknowledged the same as Josiah B. Plumb and I know them to be the same and identical person. Also that I was well and personally acquainted with Thomas Clark Street the grantee in the Quit Claim Deed mentioned last above and I know him to be the same and identical person as Thomas C. Street the grantor in a Warranty Deed dated April 19<sup>th</sup> 1871 recorded in Deed Record 5 page 145 and conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  13-77-29 and that he was a single man at the time he made the above conveyance.
