I, James V. Kirk, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am a resident of said County and State and have been for the last 37 years. That I was well and personally acquainted with Geo Kingery grantee in a deed dated August 26th, 1881, recorded in Deed Record No. 17, page 206 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying the $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 29-74-28, and I know that he is the same and identical person as George W. Kingery, who with his wife joining, conveyed said land (and other land) to W.G. Kelley by deed dated March 6th, 1902, and recorded in Deed Record 43, page 304 of the records of Madison County, Iowa. The the George W. Kingery, named as the mortgagee in a certain mortgage dated March 6th, 1902, executed by W.G. Kelley and wife, as shown by Mortgage Record 42, page 206 of the records of said County, is the same and identical person as G.W. Kingery, who cancelled said mortgage on the margin of the record thereof on February 18th, 1905. That I was also well and personally acquainted with Allen Blythe, grantee in a deed from B.C. Litton, President of the Board of School Directors of Monroe Township, Madison County, Iowa, dated August 30th, 1881 and recorded in Deed Record No. 19, page 359 of the records of said County, and know him to be the same person as A.B. Blythe, who with his wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 29-74-28 to George W. Kingery by deed dated August 31st, 1881, and recorded in Deed Record No. 19, page 358 of the records of said County, and that he is the same person as A.B. Blythe and Allen Blythe, respectively, mentioned in the proceedings to quiet the title filed in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, on October 2nd 1879, in which J.C. Blythe et al were plaintiffs and E.L. Macumber, administrator of the estate of Benjamin Blythe, deceased, et al were defendants in which cause the decree of Court is recorded in Circuit Court Record No. 3, Pg 592 of the Court Records of Madison County, Iowa.
