I, Lewis Thornburg being first sworn do depose and say that I have lived in Madison County, Iowa, since the year 1857; that I was well and personally acquainted with Benjamin Lindsey, who on March 11th 1857 platted an Addition to the City of Winterset, Madison County, Iowa, and that I was also well and personally acquainted with John Rutt Jr. to whom the said Benjamin Lindsey sold and conveyed Lots One and Two of said Lindsey's Addition, by deed dated March 6th 1856, and shown of record on page 141 of deed record E of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that the said ~~said~~ John Rutt Jr. and his wife whose name I disremember lived upon and occupied said premises and no person by the name of John Root ever lived upon or occupied the same after the said plat was made by the said Lindsey, and the said name John Root appearing on the records of said deed is evidently a mistake of the Recorder, and the person to whom the said deed was made and delivered was the said John Rutt Jr.; all of which is true as I verily believe; and I have no personal interest in making this Affidavit.
