Iowa, which deed is recorded in deed record "0" page 129 of Madison County, Iowa, deed records, and that at the date of the execution of said deed the said Levi Pierce and Amy Pierce, were husband and wife.

I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John McNeal during the years 1864 and 1865, and know that John McNeal and John McNiell grantee in Warranty deed from Levi Pierce and Amy Pierce his wife, of date September 10th 1864 and recorded in deed record "0" page 129 of Madison County, Iowa, deed records, and John McNeal who joined by his wife Sarah A. McNeal executed a warranty deed to Emanuel Sulgrove which deed is dated January 25th 1865 and recorded in book "W" page 189 of Madison County, Iowa, deed records, are one and the same identical person, or in other words that the said John McNiell grantee in the first above mentioned deed and John McNeal one of the grantors in the last above mentioned deed, are one and the same identical person, namely John McNeal.
