Houk who at one time owned the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  5-75-27. That said land was conveyed to him by I.D. Guiberson, as shown at No. 28 of the attached abstract. That the said Isaac G. Houk on November 4th 1878, conveyed to Thomas F. Mardis the West 12 acres of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  5-75-27, and on December 13th 1880 conveyed the balance of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  5-75-27 to said Mardis but in executing said Deeds, he signed his name "I.G. Houk" And I know of my own personal knowledge that the said Isaac Houk and I.G. Houk were one and the same person; for there never was but one person of that name who ever owned said land.
