I S.S. Guiberson being duly sworn on oath state that I was a resident of Madison County, State of Iowa, That I was well acquainted with Josephine S. Mayo who at one time owned N $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5-75-27. That said land was conveyed to her on November 1st 1864 by M. Glazebrook as Admr. of Israel D. Guiberson dec'd as shown at No 41 of attached abstract, but that in said deed the grantee's name was written "Josephine Mayo" the middle initial "S" being omitted. And I know of my own personal knowledge that the said Josephine S. Mayo and Josephine Mayo were one and the same person; for there never was but one person of that name who ever owned said land.
