I, Henry J. Fett being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I am a brother of Jacob J. Fett, deceased who died on or about October 22, 1893 intestate and seized of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty (20), Township Seventy Seven (77) North, Range Twenty Nine (29) West of the Fifth P.M. Iowa as shown by deed recorded in book 30 page 196 Madison County, Iowa records; that I acted as the administrator of said estate under the name of H.J. Fett and that Louisa Fett, widow, Harvey Fett, grantors and Laura E. Boyle, grantee in a certain Quit Claim deed, conveying the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of 20-77-29 and recorded in book 39 page 176 of Madison County, Iowa records, constitute the widow the heirs, the only heirs and all the heirs at law of said Jacob J.
