I, J.H. Henderson of Indianola, Iowa, being first duly sworn on oath state that I was personally acquainted with "Christopher F. Spray" to whom John Spray and wife Margaret Spray conveyed the North Half of Northeast Quarter of Section 26, and the Southeast Quarter of Section 23, all in Township 77 North, of Range 29 West of the 5th P.M. in Madison County, Iowa, said deed being of date January 31st 1862 and recorded in Deed Record K page 296 on February 14, 1862, Madison County Records, and who thereafter conveyed said land to one Thomas G. Barnes under date of September 8th 1864 and recorded May 29th 1865 in Deed Record P. page 126 of Madison County Records, under name of "C.F. Spray"; that at the time of their said conveyance, said John Spray and Margaret Spray were husband and wife; that said "Christopher F. Spray" and "C.F. Spray" was one and the same party; that said Christopher F. Spray was my brotherinlaw and recently died, and I have personal knowledge of said facts stated.
