State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, W.W. Crawford of said County and State, on oath say that I am a son of Oliver Crawford to whom, on or about the 7th day of February 1855, James Connel and wife, Margaret, conveyed the North East Quarter (¼) of the North West Quarter (¼) of Section Twenty nine (29), Township Seventy six (76) North of Range Twenty-six (26), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa; that the spelling of the name of Oliver Crawford in said conveyance as Oliver Crofford was a clerical error and that Oliver Crofford, the grantee in the said conveyance from the said James Connel, was the same and identical person as the Oliver Crawford, the grantor in the conveyance of said real estate to Thomas W. Polwell, dated on or about April 8, 1857; that John W. Wilken, the other grantee in the said conveyance from said James Connel, was the same and identical person as the J. Wilkin or J.W. Wilkin, the other grantor who joined with said Oliver Crawford and wife in the conveyance of the said real estate to said Thomas W. Polwell; that Jas. Miseldine, as his name appears on the record of a conveyance of said real estate to him from Martha McDowell and husband, Robert McDowell, dated March 15, 1886, was the same and identical person as the J.G. Missildine who, on or about October 1, 1887, conveyed the said real estate to William M. Black; that the true and correct name of said Missildine was Joseph G. Missildine and that the error in his first name in the said conveyance to him was occasioned by reason of writing the abbreviation of the name instead of writing the name in full, but that I personally know that the grantee in the conveyance of said real estate from said Martha McDowell and husband was the same and identical person as the grantor in the conveyance of said real estate to said William M. Black aforesaid. That I have lived within about a mile of said real estate for over fifty years last past and have been personally acquainted with all of the owners and occupants thereof, and that the matters stated herein are true as I believe.
