I, S.G. Ruby, of said County and State on oath say that I was a son in law of William Ogden, to whom Jacob Trouth on or about August 15, 1865, executed a mortgage on the North East Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South West Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the North West Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South East Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty Three (33) in Township Seventy six (76) North, of Range Twenty six (26), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, said mortgage being recorded in Deed record "I" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 492 thereof; and also to whom the said Jacob Trouth and wife executed another mortgage on the same land on or about June 8th, 1867, recorded in Deed record "R" of said County, at page 284 thereof that I am the same man who as agent for said William Ogden afterwards cancelled and satisfied said mortgage on the record; that I had authority to receive payment of the indebtedness secured by said mortgages, and to satisfy the same on record, that the indebtedness secured by said mortgages was paid and satisfied, and the evidences thereof surrendered, and the said mortgages do not constitute liens on said real estate,
