I, Mary E. Munger, on oath say that I am the surviving widow of M.C. Munger who at one time lived in Madison County, Iowa, and to whom William W. Kelso, on or about January 6, 1857, conveyed the West Half (1/2) of the South West Quarter (2) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township Seventy Four (74), North of Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa; that said M.C. Munger died intestate on or about the 8th day of November 1873, leaving me surviving as his widow, and that his estate has long since been settled; that I am the Mary E. Munger who, on or about May 28, 1878, executed a quit claim deed for said land to Joseph Barlien; that the Mary E. Stoneall and John M. Munger who joined with me in the execution of said deed were the sole and only heirs at law of said M.C. Munger, and that at the time of the execution of said deed myself and the said Mary E. Stoneall and John M. Munger were each unmarried.
