State of Iowa County of Madison SS:

I, Ed E. Wasson, being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am a son of Jehiel Wasson, who is now deceased, That I know that my Father, the said Jehiel Wasson, entered from the United States Government the North West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township Seventy Seven (77) North of Range Twenty Nine (29) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, That in making the entry of said land by mistake his name was spelled Johiel Wasson and that said Johiel Wasson named in the entry of said land and the the patent thereto, which entry was made and dated October 25, 1854, and the patent to the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Nineteen (19) was dated June 1, 1855, and the patent for the West Fractional Half (W Fr $\frac{1}{2}$) of the North West Quarter and the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Nineteen (19), was patented to him May 15, 1855, under the name of Johiel Wasson. That after said land was entered and patented to him, my said Father Jehiel Wasson took possession of said land under said original entry and patents and used, held and controlled the same until he conveyed the West 100.34 acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township Seventy Seven (77) Range Twenty Nine (29), to Lewis Wagner, under date of July 1, 1875, and which deed was recorded July 7, 1875 in deed Record 11 on page 248 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; and that the said Jehiel Wasson named in said conveyance to Lewis Wagner is the same person who entered and to whom said land was patented by the United States under the name of Johiel Wasson, That the mortgage executed by Lewis Wagner to Jehuil Wasson dated July 1, 1875, recorded July 7, 1875, in Mortgage record 7 on page 33, of the mortgage records of Madison County, Iowa, was in fact a mortgage to Jehiel Wasson, and that by mistake the name was recorded as Jehuil Wasson, and that the marginal entry made in said mortgage record reciting as follows:- "August 31, 1876 I hereby acknowledge satisfaction in full of the annexed mortgage (Signed) "J. Wasson"; was signed by my said Father who frequently and generally wrote his name J. Wasson. That I have examined said marginal cancellation and that the name J. Wasson signed thereto, is, in my judgment, the genuine signature of my said Father, Jehiel Wasson. All of which is true as I verily believe.
