I, Mary E. Rogers being duly sworn do depose and say, that I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and have been for more than 50 years last past, that I was well and personally acquainted with one Americus Vespucius Page, who formerly lived in Monroe Township, in the aforesaid County, I further depose and say that said Pages' name was sometimes written Americus Page and sometimes A. Page and sometimes A.V. Page, and that I know of my own knowledge that Americus Page, grantee in a certain warranty deed of date May 23rd 1864, whereby there was conveyed to him the West Half of the South West Quarter of Section Two, and certain other lands in Section Three, all in Township Seventy Four North, Range Twenty Eight, West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, which deed was recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "O" on page 104 thereof; and Americus Page, the grantee in a certain warranty deed executed by Lucy Jane and Franklin Bosworth on May 23rd 1864, whereby they conveyed to the said page, the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter in said Section Three and said Township and Range, which warranty deed is recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "O" on page 103 thereof; and A. Page the grantor in a warranty deed to Susan E. Page of date March 5th 1866, whereby there was conveyed the undivided half of the East Half of the South East Quarter of Section Three, and other lands, in said Township and Range, which deed is recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "T" on page 433 thereof; and A. Page the grantee in a warranty deed from Edward M. Greenway Jr. and wife, of date December 1st 1865, whereby there was conveyed the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of said Section Three in said Township and Range, which deed is recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "Q" on page 371 thereof; and A. Page the patentee in a patent issued by the State of Iowa on August 5th 1864, conveying to said A. Page the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of said Section Three in said Township and Range, the same being recorded in deed record "Q" on page 105 thereof, all refer to one and the same person. I further depose and say that A. Page the plaintiff in a certain action in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, vs Edward A. Temple, commenced at the April 1866 term of said Court; and A.V. Page and wife, the grantors in a certain warranty deed of date March 30th 1869, whereby said grantors conveyed to one Isaac Callison the West Half of the South West Quarter of Section Two, and certain lands in Section Three, all in the

aforesaid Township and Range, which deed is recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "3" on page 89 thereof; and A. Page the grantee in a Sheriff's deed of date June 8th 1867, whereby there was conveyed to said A. Page the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of said Section Three in said Township and Range, which Sheriff's deed is recorded in the Record "U" at page 20 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, all refer to one and the same person, and that wherever the name A. Page A.V. Page, and Americus Page appear in the title to the land hereinbefore referred to, are all one and the same identical person; and that A. Page on March 15th 1866 was the husband of Susan E. Page the grantee in a certain warranty deed of date March 5th 1866, the same being recorded in Madison County, Iowa deed record "T" on page 433 thereof. All of which is true as I verily believe.
