I, James Bertholf being duly sworn do depose and say that I am a resident of said County and State and have been for more than fifty years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with one Joseph C.P. Malone, who on June 12th 1851, entered from the Government of the United States, the following described real estate, as appears on the Original Entry Record of Madison County, Iowa, to-wit: The South West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Two (2), and the East Half of the South East Quarter, and the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Three (3), all in Township Seventy Four (74) North, of Range Twenty Eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, and I further depose and say that I know of my own knowledge that the grantor J.C.P. Malone in a Warranty deed of date August 31st 1855, conveying the above described and other lands, to Franklin Bosworth, the same being recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "D" on page 103 thereof, is one and the same person as the aforesaid Joseph C.P. Malone who entered the land first herein described; I further depose and say that the grantee J.C.P. Malone in a certain warranty deed acknowledged March 13th 1855 by Hawkins Judd and wife Almira, whereby said Judd and wife conveyed the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Three (3) in the aforesaid Township and Range, said deed being recorded in Madison County, Iowa, deed record "A" on page 563, is one and the same person as the grantor J.P. C. Malone, who on August 31st 1855, by warranty deed, conveyed the land last above described to Lucy Jane Bosworth, said deed being recorded in said County deed record "D" on page 104 thereof; and I further depose and say that Allice Malone, who signed as the wife of J.C.P. Malone, the aforesaid warranty deed recorded in said deed record "D" on page 103 thereof, is one and the same person as Alice Malone, who signs as the wife of J.C.P. Malone, the aforesaid warranty deed recorded in the aforesaid deed record "D" on page 104 thereof. All of which is true, as I verily believe.
