State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, George A. Potter, on oath say that I am now and for more than Forty years last past have been a resident either of the town of Patterson, Iowa or have resided in the immediate vicinity of said town; that I was well and personally acquainted with Alexander Pattison to whom Robert Wilkin, on or about July 19, 1870, conveyed the said land upon which the town of Patterson, Iowa, was afterwards platted; that he was the same and identical man as the Alexander Pattison and Alex Patterson who with his wife Margaret A. afterwards conveyed a right of way across said land to the Des Moines Winterset and Southwestern Railroad Company, and was the same and identical man as the Alex Patterson who, with his wife Margaret, afterwards conveyed a right of way to said Des Moines, Winterset and Southwestern R.R. Co., and that he was the same and identical man as the Alexander Patterson who, with his wife Margaret A., on or about March 5, 1872, made a plat of the Town of Patterson, Iowa, which plat was afterwards recorded in the office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, and was the same and identical man as the Alexander Pattison, who, with his wife, M.A. conveyed to M.E. Ralston Lots 3 and 4 in Block 7 in the town of Patterson, Iowa, and was the same and identical man as the Alexander Patterson, who, with his wife M.A. conveyed to Mattie Thompson, on or about March 27, 1882, Lot 3 in Block 12 in the Town of Patterson, Iowa. In other words, in all conveyances of real estate in the town of Patterson, Iowa, or of land upon which the town of Patterson, Iowa, is situated, Alexander Patterson and Alexander Pattison or Alex Patterson and Alex Pattison are one and the same man; that I was personally acquainted with him for many years and that the facts above stated are true as I believe.
