We, O. Bussanmus and C.E. Huglin of said State and county, first being duly sworn, upon our oath depose and say that we have been each a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for 40 years last past; that we were well and personally acquainted with the Joachim Huglin, who entered, and to whom was patented, the North East Fractional Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section One, in Township Seventy Five North of Range 26 West of the 5th P.M. That the certified book of original entries on file in the Recorders office for Madison County, Iowa, shows that said land was entered by, and patented to, Joacum Hydlen, as near as the writing can be made out; but that in truth and fact, said land was entered by, and patented to, Joachim Huglin, and the actual possession thereof was entered into, by the said Joachim Huglin under and by virtue thereof.

And we well and personally know that the said Joachim Huglin is the same and identical person as Joachim Huiglin, to whom Henry Fudge and wife Amelia conveyed the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section One in Township Seventy five (75) North, of Range Twenty six (26) West of the 5th P.M. by deed dated September 20th 1870 and recorded at page 84 of deed record 4 of the records of Madison County, Iowa.

We further depose and say, that the said Joachim Huglin, was the same and identical person as the Joacilin Hoglin, who, as shown by said records, was the grantee in a deed from John S. Jordan and George W. Jordan and wife Maria, of date May 4th 1865, which deed conveyed to the said Joachim Huglin, the North West Fractional Quarter of the North West Quarter of said Section One in Township Seventy five North, of Range Twenty Six (26) West of the 5th P.M. And that to our personal knowledge, the said Joachim Huglin, is the same and identical person as the Joacum Huglin who was the grantee in a deed of the land last above described from George W. Gordon and wife Mariah, and John S. Gordon and wife Mary W. which deed bears date of July 7th 1856, and is recorded in book H at page 394, of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa.

The said Joachim Huglin, who was the real and actual grantee in each of the conveyances hereinbefore described, and who took possession of the premises conveyed, under said conveyances, brought action in the District Court for Madison County, Iowa, in 1865, asking for decree of court, confirming his title to said lands, and such decree was entered. We well and personally know, that the Joacum Hydlen, first herein mentioned, the Joacilin Hoglin, the Joacum Huglin, and the Joachim Huiglin, mentioned and described herein, all refer to one and the same identical person, namely, Joachim Huglin. Further deponents say not.
