I, Antepas Simpson of said County and State, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John Abernathy who was the grantee in a deed from James Hopkins and wife, dated January 25th 1876, conveying the SWA NEA Sec 29-74-27, his name being spelled in said deed by mistake "Abbernathy" and I well and personally know that John Abbernathy, grantee in said deed, and John Abernathy, who conveyed said land to Henry C. Pike, by deed dated Pebruary 7th, 1876, is one and the same person. That I was also well and personally acquainted with the said Henry C. Pike, grantee in the aforesaid deed and also with his wife Mary J. Pike. That the said Henry C. Pike died, intestate, about the month of May, A.D. 1877, and the said Mary J. Pike died, intestate, about the month of April A.D. 1881, and that the sole and only heirs at law of the said Henry C. Pike and Mary J. Pike were on October 1st, 1881 their children Albert C. Pike, Carbline Pike and Jane Pike, who were at that time all minors.
