I, E.W. Harrell a)resident of the State and County
aforesaid being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally
acquainted with Lewis W. Harrell to whom Albert Owen and wife on September 3rd 1867, convey-
ed the undivided one-half of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of 24-75-28 as shown by Deed
Record "V" page 411 of the records of Madison County Iowa, and of my own personal knowledge
known that said Lewis W. Harrell is the same and identical person as the L.W. Harrell who,
together with his wife Martha Harrell on March 23rd 1870, conveyed said land to E.L. Harrell
as shown by Deed Record 4 page 44 of said records. That William Ackelson to whom E.L. Harrell
and wife on October 22nd 1870, conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of 24-75-28, as
shown by Deed Record 4 page 186 of said records, is the same and identical person as the
William Ackleson who on September 1st 1883, conveyed to E.W. Harrell, the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of 24-75-28, as shown by Deed Record 23 page 159 of said records.
That Adalasca Harrell to whom myself and wife on December 17th 1887, conveyed the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$
of 24-75-28, as shown by Deed Record 26 page 460 of said records, was my son, and the same
and identical person as the A.M. Harrell whose estate was administered in the Probate Court
of Madison County Iowa in the year 1898. That said Adalasca Harrell died intestate on May
28th 1898 without issue, leaving his widow Hattie Harrell and myself E.W. Harrell his father
as his only heirs at law. That his widow Hattie Harrell afterwards married one W.E. Pooler
and is the same and identical person as the Hattie S. Pooler who on October 16th 1901,
conveyed all her interest in the above described land to Edgar Harrell, as shown by Deed
Record 43 page 24 of said records. That I am personally acquainted with William Oliver
Jessup named in the Registry of Heirs in the estate of Isaac Jessup deceased, shown at entry
No 23 of Abstract, and of my own personal knowledge know that said William Oliver Jessup
is the same and identical person as the William O. Jessup who together with Charles E.
Jessup, conveyed to myself and Edgar Harrell the land described in Deed Record 43 page 20
of said records. That in said deed our names should have been "Harrell" instead of Herrell.
Affiant further sayeth not.
