State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, Elvis Stout a resident of the State and County aforesaid being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was personally acquainted with Henry C. Clary and Lucy A. Clary who on November 4th 1865 conveyed to one Daniel M. Cortner the following described land to-wit:- Commencing at the Southwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, Township 76 North, Range 26 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. of Iowa, and running thence North 52 rods, thence East 26  $\frac{2}{3}$  rods, thence South 12 rods, thence East 53  $\frac{1}{3}$  rods, thence South 40 rods, thence West 80 rods to the place of beginning, containing 22 acres more or less, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Record "Q" page 300 of the Records of Madison County Iowa, and of my own personal knowledge know that the said Henry C. Clary and Lucy A. Clary were husband and wife on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: November 4th 1865. That I was well and personally acquainted with the said Daniel M. Cortner on March 10th 1866, at which time he conveyed to myself the above described land as shown by deed recorded in Deed Record "S" page 11 of said records, and of my own personal knowledge know that the said Daniel M. Cortner was a single and unmarried man on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: March 10th 1866, That in said deed of conveyance last above described, my name was by mistake spelled Elias Stout instead of Elvis Stout. That I was well and personally acquainted with Mary Jane Wiggins and Luther N. Wiggins on March 18th 1872 at which time they conveyed to myself the above described land as shown by deed recorded in Deed Record 6 page 419 of said records, and of my own personal know-that the said Mary Jane Wiggins and Luther N. Wiggins were wife and husband on the date of said conveyance, to-wit: March 18th 1872. That in the deed recorded in Deed Record 30 on page 249 of said records, wherein Gibson Cunningham and wife conveyed to myself the land above described, my name was by mistake spelled Elves Stout, instead of Elvis Stout. That I am in no way interested in making this affidavit other than to establish of record the facts as herein set forth.
