I, M.L. Silliman, of said County and State, on oath say that I was Sheriff of Madison County Iowa, during the years 1896, 1897, 1898, and 1899; that I remember the cases of J.H. Mack vs Wesley Butrum or Wesley Burtrum, at No 7105 in the District Court of said County, and J.H. Mack vs Harry or Hanry J. Lord et al at No 7106 in said Court, and of J.M. Lee vs Wesley Burtrum or Butrum at No 5795 in said Court; that I remember of the service of the original notice, and of the notices of levy on real estate, and of a Sheriff's sale of real estate made in one of said cases, and that wherever the name Wesley Butrum or Wesley Burtrum appears it refers to one and the same man, and wherever the name Lizzie Butrum or Lizzie Burtrum appears it refers to one and the same woman, his wife; that all the original notices in said causes were served on the proper parties, that is on Wesley Butrum and wife Lizzie Butrum, and that if in any of the returns of service of any of the notices in any of said causes the name appears as Burtrum, it only so appears because of misunderstanding as to the correct manner of spelling as I remember the transactions, and know the notices were in fact served on said Wesley Butrum and Lizzie Butrum; that the Israel J. Lee, and that if her name appears any place as Unice, it is only by reason of oversight.
