I, D.G. Ratliff of said County and State on oath say that I was Sheriff of said County and State in the year 1879 when a mortgage given by W.H.H. Dabney and wife to Elizabeth Knowlton on the South East Quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Township Seventy Six (76), North of Range Twenty Nine (29), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa was foreclosed, and that I conducted the Sheriff's sale; that the Elizabeth Knowlton who purchased said real estate at the Sheriff's sale, and to whom it was conveyed in December 1880, by J.R. Davis, the then Sheriff was the same and identical woman as Mrs E.P. Knowlton, who afterwards executed a contract to Convey the same to Jannett Mekemson, and as the Elizabeth P. Knowlton, who on or about March 1st, 1893, conveyed the same to W.H. Doak; that the W.H. Doak, as the record shows, who on or about October 12th, 1893, conveyed the same real estate to Thomas R. Buchanan, was in fact W.H. Doak, to whom Elizabeth P. Knowlton had conveyed the same, his name appearing as Doak only by error or mistake in drawing or recording the conveyance. That I have personally known all of the parties herein referred to, and that the statements contained herein are true as I believe.
