State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, William Barton, being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I now am and for more than 50 years last past have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa; that I am the same and identical person as the William Borton, named as grantee in a certain Warranty Deed, dated July 8-1861, and recorded in Deed Record "K" of the records of Madison County, Iowa, at page 160 thereof, wherein there was conveyed to me the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 32-75-27 (and other land); that the writing of my name in said record as "Borton" was a mistake of the Recorder, in recording said deed and should have been written "Barton" that being my correct name. I further state that I am the same and identical person as Wm Barton, who conveyed said above described land to James Travis, by Warranty Deed, dated September, 29-1864, and recorded in Deed Record "O" of the records of Madison County, Iowa, at page 205 thereof; that the word Wm. is an abbreviation for the name William. I further state that Drusilla Barton, who joined with me in the execution of said Deed was at that time my wife. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with James Compton, who was named as grantee in a certain Warranty Deed dated March 16-1861, and recorded in Deed Record "K" of the records of Madison County, Iowa, at page 155 thereof, wherein there was conveyed to him said above described real estate, and that I know of my own personal knowledge that he was the same and identical person as the James R. Compton, who conveyed to me said above described real estate, by Warranty Deed, dated July, 8 1861, and recorded in Deed Record "K" of the records of Madison County, Iowa, at page 160 thereof; I further state that at the time of the execution of said deed he the said James Compton, or James R. Compton, was an unmarried man. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with E.W. Herrell, named as Mortgagee in a certain Mortgage of said land, dated August 18-1871, and recorded in Mortgage Record 10 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, at page 61 thereof; and I personally know that he was the same and identical person as E.W. Hearrell, who executed a release for said Mortgage on the margin of said record on the 19th day of February, 1889, and that his correct name was E.W. Harrell. That I have no interest in said above described real estate but make the above statements to correct the errors in the above mentioned records and for no other purpose.
