I, M.R. Sheldon, a resident of the City of Winterset, Madison County Iowa, being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with one Delia S. White, who on January 28th 1856 conveyed to Benjamin Lindsey the following described property to-wit:

Beginning at the South East corner of the North West Corner of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section No. one (1) in Township No. Seventy Five (75) North of Range No. Twenty eight (28) West of Fifth P.M. of Iowa. And running thence North 49 rods $16\frac{1}{2}$ links West 38 rods $16\frac{1}{2}$ links, South 49 rods $16\frac{1}{2}$ links, East 38 rods $16\frac{1}{2}$ links, to place of beginning, and containing 12 acres. That I know of my own personal knowledge that the said Della S. White was a single and unmarried woman, on the date of said conveyance be it January 28th 1856. That her husband Elijah White died on the 16th day of November 1854, and to my certain knowledge the said Delia S. White never married but remained a widow ever after the death of her husband the said Elijah White, until her death which occurred on the 20th day of July 1879 that the said Delia S. White was my Aunt. That I am in no way interested in making above statements.
