State of Iowa, Madison County, SS:

I, J.N. Trester, of said County and state, being sworn depose and say that I was well and intimately acquainted with James Trester who acquired title to the North East Quarter (¼) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Seventy-seven (77) North of Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa. That said James Trester died seized of said real estate, leaving his wife, Anna Trester, surviving, and the following named children and heirs at law, to-wit: Mary Jane Atcheson, Martin J. Trester, William P. Trester, Rebecca E. Hart, Jacob B. Trester, Jasper N. Trester, and Charles H. Trester, and said last named persons were the only heirs at law of said James Trester, deceased. That the said Mary Jane Atcheson, who is named as one of the heirs at law of James Trester, deceased, is the same identical person as the Mary J. Atcheson who is named as one of the grantors in the deed recorded in Deed Record 14 at page 436, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and she is the same identical person as the Mary J. Atcheson who is named in the partition proceedings in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, wherein a petition for partition was filed by M.J. Trester, W.P. Trester and J.N. Trester, said petition having been filed March 12, 1883. That the said Martin J. Trester, who is named as one of the heirs at law of James Trester, deceased, is the same identical person as the Martin J. Trester who is named as one of the grantors in a deed recorded in Deed Record 23 at page 272, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and he is the same identical person as the M.J. Trester who is named in the partition proceedings in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, wherein a petition was filed for partition by M.J. Trester and others on the said 12th day of March 1883. That the said William P. Trester, who is named as one of the heirs at law of James Trester, deceased, is the same identical person as the W.P. Trester who is named as grantee in a deed recorded in Deed Record 14 at page 439, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and the same identical person as the W.P. Trester named in the partition proceedings commenced in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, by M.J. Trester and others against J.B. Trester and others, which petition was filed March 12, 1883. That the said Jacob B. Trester, who is named as one of the heirs at law of James Trester, deceased, is the same identical person as the J.B. Trester and others defendants, the petition in said cause being filed in said Court March 12, 1883. That the Charles H. Trester, who is named as one of the heirs at law of James Trester, deceased, is the same identical person as the C.H. Trester who is named as one of the grantors in a deed recorded in Deed Record 14 at page 397 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and the same identical person as the C.H. Trester who is named as one of the grantors in a deed recorded in Deed Record 14 at page 440 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and the same identical person as the C.H. Trester who is named as one of the defendants in the partition proceedings wherein M.J. Trester and others were plaintiffs and J.B. Trester and others were defendants, wherein the petition for partition was filed in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, on the 12th day of March, 1883. That I was well and intimately acquainted with each and all of the children and heirs at law of James Trester deceased, and know what their correct names are, and that their names are correctly set out in the registry of heirs filed in said estate and wherever their names appear differently in the chain of title to the North East Quarter (¼) of Section Thirty six (36) Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, or to any part of said real estate, it is because of not giving their names in full, or giving their initials instead of their names, and wherever the name appears by initials in said chain of title, it refers to the same person who is an heir at law of James Trester, deceased, and whose name is correctly set out in said registry of heirs. That I am one of the children and heirs at law of James Trester deceased, and well know all his children and heirs at law and my full name is Jasper N. Trester but I sign my name simply J.N. Trester.
