Temple conveyed the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 23-75-27 by deed dated August 17th 1858 and recorded in Record "H", page 551 of the records of Madison County Iowa, and that the said E.B. Bell and the Elisha B. Bell who conveyed said land to Benjamin James, Jr. by deed dated August 13th 1855 and recorded in Record "D", page 529 of the records of Madison County Iowa, were one and the same person.

I was also well acquainted with John Struthers who conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 23-75-27 to William McConly by deed dated February 23rd 1857, and recorded in Record "P", page 363 of the records of Madison County Iowa, and know that at the time of making said conveyance the said John Struthers was an unmarried man.

I was also well acquainted with the William McConly, the grantee in the deed last referred to, and know that the said William McConly, and the William McConnelsee who conveyed the said land to Theodore Rudeman by deed dated April 20th 1867 and recorded in Record "T", page 382 of the records of Madison County Iowa, were one and the same person. Further deponent sayeth not.
