This is to certify that at a special meeting of the Winterset Cemetery Improvement Association, of Winterset, Iowa, held on June Twenty-seventh, A.D. 1910; notice of which meeting had been given by publication in the newspapers of Winterset, Iowa, on June Twenty-third, A.D. 1910, and which meeting was called for the purpose, among other things, of amending the Articles of Incorporation were by proper motion adopted; the same being voted for affirmatively by all parties of said corporation who were then present. And we, the undersigned, hereby certify that the Articles of said corporation have been amended as follows:

ARTICLE X.

This Association may acquire property to be used for Cemetery purposes and have the right to plat the same and sell lots therein and execute deeds of conveyance therefor.

ARTICLE XI.

This Association, by its Directors, may incur indebtedness for the purchase of lands for Cemetery purposes and for the improvement thereof, and by authority of its Board of Directors may issue evidences of indebtedness therefor.
