I, W. G. Dorrell, first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with A.W. Larrimore to whom C.D. Ravington and wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -sec. 16-74-27 by deed dated April 2nd 1864 and recorded in Record "k" page 456, and that he was the same and identical person as the A.W. Lorimer who afterward, with his wife M.J. Lorimer, conveyed said real estate (except the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ thereof) and other land, to Joseph Roe by deed dated October 20th 1869 and recorded in deed record 2 page 168, and who with his wife M. J. Lorimer conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 16-74-27 to Jery Shearer by deed dated May 1st 1867 and recorded in Record "8" page 556.

That I was also well acquainted with J.C. Roe to whom Joseph Roe and wife Martha A. Roe conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 16-74-27 (except the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ thereof), and other land, by deed dated July 8th 1875, and recorded in deed Record 12 page 61, and that the said J.C. Roe was the same and identical person as the John C. Roe who afterward conveyed said real estate to Joseph Roe by deed dated November 28th 1879 and recorded in deed record 15 page 459 and that at the time of executing said last named conveyance the said John C. Roe was an unmarried man and competent to convey. Further deponent sayeth not.
