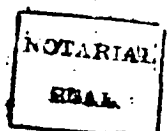
State of Iowa, Warren County SS:

That I am now and have been for about forty years a resident of Warren County, Iowa, and that I was personally acquainted with the persons named in this affidavit, and that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the facts herein stated. That the William E. Tomlins who is named as one of the grantors in a certain deed dated February 10<sup>th</sup> 1873 and recorded in Deed Record 7 page 240 of Madison County, Iowa, which deed conveyed to Patrick Dooley the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty Four in Township Seventy-seven North, of Range Twenty-six West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, is the same and identical person as the W.E. Tomlins who is named in the acknowledgment of said deed and that he is also the same and identical person as the Willm E. Tomlins who is named in the granting clause of said deed, his correct and full name being William E. Tomlins. That the Nelson S. Iowa, is the same and identical person as the N.S. Howell who is named as one of the grantors in a certain deed to Patrick Dooley, dated February 23rd, 1881, and recorded in Deed Record 19 page 8 of Madison County, Iowa, conveying the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of the said Section last above described herein. That the Eliza Dooley who is named as one of the heirs of Patrick Dooley, deceased, in the registry of heirs filed in the matter of the estate of the said Patrick Dooley in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court of the State of Iowa in and for Madison County, is the same and identical person as the Elizabeth Dooley who is named as one of the heirs of Bridget Dooley, deceased, in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of the said Bridget Dooley, deceased, in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court of the State of Iowa in and for Madison County, her full name being Elizabeth Dooley.
