I, Miles White, Jr., being first duly affirmed, do say that I am one of the legattees named in the will of Miles White, deceased, who died in the City of Baltimore, Maryland, on or about the 12th day of March 1876, leaving a last will and Testament which was admitted to probate in said City of Baltimore on the 16th day of March 1876; that the several tracts of land in the State of Iowa devised by said will were duly selected by or for the parties entitled thereto in accordance with the provisions of said will, that under and by virtue of the 14th section of said will, all lands if any, owned by said Miles White at the time of his death situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, passed to and become the property of Francis White the residuary legatee named in said will, except 200 acres of land set apart for the affiant herein, under the provisions of Section 4 of said will, and conveyed to me by the residuary Legatee in said will, March 11th 1878 by deed recorded in Book 15 page 201 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that the respective bequests of lands in the State of Iowa made to other person or persons than said Francis White were all fully satisfied by the selection of lands situated elsewhere than in said Madison County.
