I, A.W. Wilkinson, being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I was well and fully acquainted with Byron Rice who entered from the Government and to whom patent was issued for the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9) in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, and that the B. Rice who, with his wife, H. Cornelia Rice did, on the Twenty-ninth day of August 1857, conveyed the above described land to Joseph C.P. Malone, the conveyance for which was recorded December 1, 1857, on page 243 of Deed Record "H" of the records of Madison County, Iowa, was the same and identical person as the Byron Rice above named who entered and to whom was patented the above described lands.
