A.H. Gaumer of Urbana, Ohio, being duly sworn, deposes and says, that he has been a resident of Urbana, Ohio, for 52 years last past; that his occupation is manufacturer of carriages; that he was one of the administrators of William Warren deceased, between the years 1890 and 1893; that James Warren was a brother of said decedent; that at the time of said decedent's death said James Warren had not been heard of or from for about 35 years; that said James Warren was at one time a resident of Urbana, Ohio, and was employed by and worked in the same shop with this affiant's father that during or before the Civil War said James Warren went South and never returned; that to this deponent's knowledge no word has ever been received from him since his said departure; that this affiant believes said James Warren was either killed in said war or has since died; and that to his knowledge said James Warren left no widow or children surviving him.
