State of Iowa, Polk County SS:

I, John A. Lawless, a resident of said County and State, do on oath say, that I was well and personally acquainted with James C. Savery who had an apparent interest in the  $\frac{N}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14, and in the  $\frac{N}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, all in Township 77, North of Range 26, West of the 5th, P.M. Madison County, Iowa, who on November 22nd, A.D. 1895, together with James Callanan and wife Martha C., executed a quit claim deed therefor to N.W. Johnson, which appears of record in Book 29, at page 539, records of Madison County, Iowa; that for many years I was in the employ of said Callanan and Savery and had charge of such matters as preparing deeds and generally looking after their real estate matters, and that on said November 22, 1895, said James C. Savery was an unmarried man, as I verily believe.
