I, Chas. M. Weaver being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I have been a resident of Jackson Township, said County and State for thirty-five years last past; that if the delinquent tax records of Madison County, Iowa, show unpaid taxes against a party by the name of Chas. M. Weaver for the year 1903 in Jackson Township, Madison County, Iowa, it is against some other person and not against me, as I paid my personal taxes for that year as shown by delinquent tax receipt No. 602 in book 2 of the records in the Treasurer's Office of said County and State. That I know that at about that time there was another man in Jackson Township, bearing the same name as myself, and believe said taxes for the year 1903 which show unpaid were against him. I further state that I am the owner in fee simple of 80 acres of land in Section 10, said Township of Jackson, Madison County, Iowa, and more particularly described as follows:- The West Half of the North East Quarter, (except the East 2 acres of the South 23 rods thereof) and the North Two (2) acres of the West 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ rods of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section, Township, and Range. Further this affiant sayeth not.
