This matter coming on for hearing upon the application of Mollie G. Lewis, acting Administratrix of the Estate of William F. Lewis, late of Jefferson County, deceased, for authority to release certain mortgages executed and delivered by N.P. Christensen and Gertrude B. Christensen, his wife, of Audubon County, State of Iowa, on the following described real estate, situate in Madison County, and State of Iowa, and bounded and described as follows:- Being the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Fifteen (15), Township Seventy-four (74), Range Twenty-eight (28), and the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section Fifteen (15), Township Seventy-four (74), and Range Twenty-eight (28), to William F. Lewis, Trustee, late of said County of Jefferson now deceased, The Court upon consideration thereof doth find that said mortgages so executed by said N. P. Christensen and his wife Gertrude B.
