Warnock, Celeste Warnock, this affiant, Sarah J. Warnock and John H. Warnock his children, his only heirs at law. I further state that each of the above named children of the said Robert Warnock were children of the said Elizabeth Warnock. And I further state that my brother John H. Warnock died in the month of January, 1865. (See Code Sec. 2498 Revision of 1860) That my Mother, Elizabeth Warnock afterward married John Shadle, and that she is now deceased, having died on or about the 20th day of December A.D. 1903.
