I, D.G. Ratliff, a resident of said County and State, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I have resided in said County since the year 1853 and was well and personally acquainted with many, if not all, of the early settlers of Madison County, Iowa, and especially with the early settlers of the Town of Winterset in said county, and among the early settlers of the town of Winterset I well and personally knew Enos Berger, who laid out and platted the West Addition to said Town, and also knew his wife Elizabeth Berger. That the last name of the said Enos Berger was often spelled "Burger", but I personally know of the said laying out of the West Addition of Winterset, Iowa, and that there was never any other person of the name of "Berger" or "Burger" connected with the platting and ownership of said West Addition, than the said Enos Berger aforesaid, the correct spelling of his name, according to my understanding, being Enos Berger.
