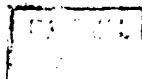

State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, W.D. Bradshaw, a resident of said County and State, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of John W. Bradshaw, who died, intestate, in Madison County, Iowa, on or about February 15th, 1895, and I well and personally know him to be the same and identical person as J.W. Bradshaw, one of the grantees in a deed from Joseph B. Loose and wife and Mary E. McManahan and husband, dated July 7th, 1881, conveying the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9 in Township 74 North, of Range 26, West 5th P.M., and also the same and identical person as the John W. Bradshaw, named as grantee in a deed from David Bradshaw and wife, dated December 21st, 1889, and recorded on page 55 of Deed Record 33 of the records of Madison County, Iowa. That this affiant is the same and identical person as Walter Bradshaw, named as one of the heirs at law in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of said John W. Bradshaw, deceased, and also the same and identical person as Walter Bradshaw, named as one of the defendants in an action for partition in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, filed in said Court January 31st, 1896, wherein Lorinda Bradshaw was plaintiff and Walter Bradshaw and wife, Nettie, and Grace M. Bradshaw were defendants, and that the W.D. Bradshaw, grantee in a deed dated August 28th, 1907, from Grace M. Bradshaw, conveying the North 5 acres of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section, Township and Range, is identical with the aforesaid Walter Bradshaw, this affiant. Further affiant saith not.
