KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

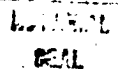
That I, George W. Curtis, Jr., of Madison County, Iowa, for a good and sufficient consideration to me in hand paid, do hereby acknowledge receipt in full from my father George W. Curtis, Sr., now of Upland, California, of all of my right, title, and interest in his estate, that is of the estate which he may leave at his death. And for such consideration I hereby waive all right, title, and interest in and to the estate of which said George W. Curtis Sr., may die seized either as claimant or heir at law, having received my interest in full. And I do hereby acknowledge that I am not now entitled to receive now or hereafter any thing of any kind from any estate or property which my said father may have at his death. And I do hereby agree not to assert any right, title, or interest in and to any estate of which my said father may die seized. The intention of this instrument being that I shall not in any way participate or share in any estate left by my said father, for the reason that my full share has been advanced to me by him, and I am not and will not be entitled to receive any thing in addition to what I have already received.
