

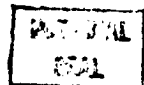

State of Iowa, Clarke County SS:

I, W.H. Roberts being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I was well and personally acquainted with W.J. Guthrie during his lifetime, and that the said W.J. Guthrie died intestate on or about the 20th day of August 1894 that at the time of his death he was a widower, his wife having died about the year 1892; that at the time of his death he owned the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 34-74-27; that he left surviving him three children, namely-J.W. Guthrie, T.A. Guthrie and M.L. Guthrie now M.L. Roberts; that these three children were his only children, and that the estate of said W.J. Guthrie was never probated but that the same has been fully settled and all debts paid. Dated at Winterset, Iowa, this 21st day of August 1911.
