State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, Thomas R. Rawlings, of said State and County first being duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am a son of James Rawlings, deceased, and was well and personally acquainted with him and all his family. That on or about December 1863 by mutual consent and agreement of each and all of the heirs at law of the said James Rawlings who died on or about September 3rd 1858 the land of said decedent to-wit: the NW4 NW4 and SW4 NE4 32-74-29 (& 80 acres of other land) was surveyed, and the interest of each heir of said decedent in said land was set off to him in severalty, and Quit Claim Deeds to such land so set apart were executed and lodged and delivered by all the other heirs, conveying to such heir all their interest in and to such land so set off in severalty. That in said partition of said estate, there was set off to Rachel Owen as her interest in severalty in said estate as an heir at law of said decedent, Seventeen (17) acres in the East part of the SW4 of NE4 32-74-29 (& other land), That all of the other heirs at law of said decedent joined in a Quit Claim Deed conveying to said Rachel Owen all their interest in the land so set off to her as above described and that said deed was by them duly executed and acknowledged and delivered to said Rachel Owen but was never recorded and is now lost. That at the death of said James Rawlings his son E.P. Rawlings was indebted to him and that to satisfy said indebtedness, Samuel Osborn the duly appointed Administrator of said intestate, obtained judgment against said E.P. Rawlings and caused his interest in said Estate to be sold at Sheriffs Sale to satisfy said indebtedness, and that at such sale the said Administrator bought in said interest and took the Sheriffs Deed therefor in his own name & as Administrator, in trust for the other heirs of said decedent but that the land so sold and by Sheriffs Deed so conveyed was and was intended to be other land than the Nine acres in the North part of East part of SW4 NE4 32-74-29 in which the said E.P. Rawlings had no interest the same being set off in severalty to Rachel Owen, and other land than the 34 acres in West part NW4 NW4 33-74-29 which said land in said division was set off to Elizabeth Green. And further that the said Rachel Owen was unmarried August 18th 1869 when she conveyed the said East part SW4 NE4 32-74-29 to me. That I make these statements from a personal knowledge of the facts and have no interest therein. Further deponent sayeth not, Signed May 7th A.D. 1884.
