Said premises described as lot numbered 124 (12 x 20) West part Book I Union Chapel Cemetery, a plat of which is recorded on page 251 of Cemetery records, in the office of the County Recorder of Madison county, Iowa. And the said township of South hereby covenants to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
