I, Eliza M. Craven, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am the Eliza M. Craven to whom J.D. Craven conveyed the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 22-74-29 by deed dated November 16, 1876 and recorded in Deed Record 12, page 501 of the records of Madison County, Iowa and that the said J.D. Craven was my then living husband. I further state that I am the Eliza M. Craven who subsequently conveyed said real estate to S.M. Craven by deed dated February 19, 1878 and recorded in Deed Record 16, page 196 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that at the date of said conveyance I was a widow. I further state that the said S.M. Craven named in last mentioned conveyance was the same identical person as the Sylvester M. Craven who subsequently reconveyed said real estate to myself by deed dated May 11th, 1878, and recorded in Deed Record 15, page 220, of the records of Madison County, Iowa.

I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Adam Bush, to whom I subsequently conveyed said real estate by deed dated October 5th, 1886, and recorded in Deed Record 26, page 44 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and know of my own personal knowledge that he was the same identical person as the Adam Busch, who with his wife Elizabeth, subsequently conveyed said real estate to S.E. Bonham by deed dated November 24th, 1899, and recorded in Deed Record 41, page 81 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa. Further deponent sayeth not.
