I, S.D. Ford a resident of the State and County aforesaid, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with one Charlotte B. Welch, who on August 9<sup>th</sup> 1858 acquired title to the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of 24-76-29, and of my own personal knowledge know that she is the same and identical person who is named in Registry of Heirs filed in the estate of A.G. Welch, deceased, as C.B. Welch, and is the same and identical person who on January 18<sup>th</sup> 1875 conveyed said land and the undivided one-third of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of 24-76-29 to James A. Cross. That Albert Welch who on August 7<sup>th</sup> 1858 acquired title to the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of 24-76-29, is the same and identical person as A.G. Welch who died seized of said land and whose estate was probated as A.G. Welch. That James A. Cross who acquired title from C.B. Welch on January 18<sup>th</sup> 1875 as above described, is the same and identical person as J.A. Cross who together with wife on February 3<sup>rd</sup> 1879, conveyed the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of 24-76-29, to Wm. Hedge. Affiant further sayeth not.
