I, D.G. Ratliff, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than fifty years last past that I was well and personally acquainted with B.C. Slayden, who on or about July 13th, 1870, conveyed unto Nathan W. Kinkennon five acres on the West side of the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty Six, Township Seventy Six, Range Twenty Seven, West of 5th P.M. Iowa, the deed being recorded in deed record three (3) of said County, at page 609 thereof; that the said B.C. Slayden lived in the Eastern part of Madison County, Iowa, for many years, and that his full name was Benjamin C. Slayden; that he was the same and identical man as the Benjamin Slader, to whom Moses Barlow and Phebe Ann Barlow on or about the third day of January, 1863, conveyed the forty acre tract off of the West side of which the five acres above described is taken.
