State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, N.B. Hollingsworth, being duly sworn depose and say as follows:- That I am now and have been for 51 years a resident of Madison County, Iowa and that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the facts stated herein. That I am well acquainted with the Isaiah T. Hollingsworth who conveyed the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Eleven in Township Seventy Four North, of Range Twenty Seven West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, except 5 acres off the South side of said forty, to James P. Dewitt on the 13th day of September, 1865, his wife Mary Elizabeth Hollingsworth having joined in said deed, and said deed being recorded in Deed Record P page 293 of Madison County, Iowa, and that he is the same and identical person as the Josiah Hollingsworth who is named as grantee in a deed conveying the real estate above described executed by Jacob Brown Sr., on February 29th, 1864 and recorded in Deed Record K page 410 of Madison County, Iowa, That his true and full name was Isaiah T. Hollingsworth, that the spelling of his name as Josiah Hollingsworth in the deed above described was a mistake on the part of the person who drew said deed or on the part of the person recording the same, That I remember the circumstance of the said Isaiah T. Hollingsworth buying and owning said land, he being a cousin of mine. That I have a cousin named Josiah Hollingsworth, that he never owned this land or claimed to own it, and that I never knew of any other person, except my said cousin by the name of Josiah Hollingsworth. That I am the N.B. Hollingsworth who made the affidavit concerning the parties above described which is dated August 9<sup>th</sup> 1898, and which was recorded March 25<sup>th</sup> 1899 in Miscellaneous record 13 page 516 of Madison County, Iowa, which affidavit recites, as shown by the record of the same, that I was well acquainted with Isiah L. Hollingsworth. That I intended to say in said affidavit that I was well acquainted with Isaiah T. Hollingsworth, and that the spelling of his name as Isiah L. Hollingsworth was a mistake made either by the person who drew or the person who recorded said affidavit. That I am well acquainted with the John R. McKee who is named as grantee in a certain deed executed by Daniel Leach and wife on July 30th, 1884 and recorded in Deed Record 23 page 562 of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying the North Half of the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Eleven in Township Seventy-four North, of Range Twenty-seven West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, and that he is the same person as the J.R. McKee who is named as grantor in a certain deed conveying the same land to William H. Meader, dated November 14<sup>th</sup> 1884, and recorded in Deed Record 24 page 35 of Madison County, Iowa.
