I, F.M. Bruce, on oath say that I was well and personally acquainted with Mary Elizabeth Bruce and Nancy Bruce named as devisees in the last will and testament of my grandmother Elizabeth Bruce, who died in Madison County, Iowa, in the year 1853. That the said Mary Elizabeth Bruce afterwards married one Richard B. Price, and said Nancy Bruce married one Mark S. Musick, and that they conveyed the land acquired by them from the estate of my said grandmother to one James Fosher, said land being the West Half of the South West Quarter of Section Three (3) Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty Eight (28), West of 5th P.M.
